

Engomi became a Municipality on 1986. First elected Mayor was Mr. Michalakis Zivanaris

The mayor today (5th) is Mr Zacharias Kyriakou, a sport reporter / journalist by profession.

According to the Municipality Law of 1985 the mayor and members of the council are elected directly from the residents every 5 years.

Nowadays, Engomi is one of the most developing residential areas of Nicosia district, with a population of 18.219 inhabitants, over an area 11 square kilometers.

The Municipal Council consists of 13 members: the Mayor, 12
Municipality Counselors and one of which and act as Vice—Mayor.

The Mayor, chairs the Council Meetings, and is the executive authority of the Municipality and supervises all the Services of the Municipality.

The Mayor is also the political head of the Municipality and the Town Clerk is in charge of the General Management.


The building used as a Town Hall is rental.

Street lighting Engomi

According to data from the EAC (Electricity Authority of Cyprus), the total electricity consumption in 2009 in the streetlights were equal to 1.922.032 kWh.

The cost for the lighting of the City seems to be particularly important as they increase from 210.000 in 2003 to 331.000 in 2011.


